

Splinternet Holdings Inc. to Install Security Solutions at Mid-Western Hospital Alliance

Splinternet Holdings Inc., Norwalk, Conn., a homeland security technology firm that develops and markets radiation detection systems, has announced it has been selected to deploy security systems and technology upgrades for a group of mid-western hospitals, doctors' offices and administration buildings under a subcontract with Argus Technologies. Splinternet's gamma radiation detection network, DefenTect, will protect hospital perimeters and portals wherever radiological treatment material is stored.

Splinternet will implement overall technology systems upgrades including computer and physical security networks at healthcare alliance locations. Splinternet threat awareness solutions are compatible with and overlay other data related systems at customer facilities. Systems work will begin in June 2008. The cost of the project is \$1.4M.
